

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE ESTABLISHING MINIMUM INSURANCE LIMITS ON CONTRACTS WITH THE CITY OF ELK GROVE

WHEREAS, in the course of negotiating contracts and agreements from time to time on behalf of the City, staff members must ask contracting parties to provide adequate insurance coverage for the protection of the City from potential liability; and

WHEREAS, the limits hereafter established are found to be adequate minimum limits available for coverage and protective of the City's interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the sum of One million (\$1,000,000) Dollars is hereby established as the minimum of combined single limit for insurance coverage by persons who enter into contract agreements with the City.
2. That the City Manager is authorized and directed to require such minimum limit in all contracts and agreements when negotiating on behalf of the City.


