A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE APPROVING THE RECEIPT OF GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE ENERGY RESOURCES CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 25403.8, the State Energy Resources Conservation and Development Commission (California Energy Commission) is authorized to provide grants to city, county or city and county governments for battery backup systems for traffic signals;

WHEREAS, in order to be eligible for funding, the battery backup systems must be used in conjunction with light emitting diode traffic signals;

BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove authorizes the City Engineer to apply for funding from the California Energy Commission for battery backup systems operating with light emitting diode traffic signals;

BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that if recommended for funding by the California Energy Commission, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove authorizes the City of Elk Grove to accept a grant up to \$12,101.82;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that the City Engineer is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of City of Elk Grove all necessary documents to implement and carry out the purpose of this resolution and to undertake all actions necessary to undertake and complete the energy efficiency project.
