**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE

2004/2005 USED OIL RECYCLING BLOCK GRANT (10th Cycle)

WHEREAS, the people of the State of California have enacted the California Oil Recycling Enhancement Act that provides funds to cities and counties to establish and maintain local used oil collection programs that encourage recycling or appropriate disposal of used oil; and

WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management Board has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of the program within the state, setting up necessary procedures governing application by cities and counties under the program; and

WHEREAS, the applicant will enter into an agreement with the State of California for implementation of a used oil collection program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove authorizes the submittal of an application to the California Integrated Waste Management Board for the Used Oil Recycling Block Grant, Fiscal Year 2004/2005.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the City of Elk Grove all necessary applications, contracts, payment requests and amendments hereto for the purposes of securing grant funds and to implement and carry out the purposes specified in the grant application.




