

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-78

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION
CONTRACT WITH GRANITE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR THE ELK GROVE-
FLORIN ROAD PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$559,447 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO APPROVE CHANGE
ORDERS FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$84,000**

WHEREAS, as part of the American Reinvestment and Recovery Act funding received by the City of Elk Grove, there remains \$660,400 available for street rehabilitation projects; and

WHEREAS, Elk Grove-Florin Road is an eligible route along the Federal Aid System of Streets making it eligible for federal funding; and

WHEREAS, Elk Grove-Florin Road between Bond Road and Second Avenue warranted pavement rehabilitation based upon the ratings listed in the City's Pavement Management System and the estimated costs for this segment was estimated to be approximately equal to available funding; and

WHEREAS, an invitation to bid was duly advertised on February 18, 2010 with bids having been received and opened March 25, 2010 and Granite Construction Company was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Finds that the project is exempt from environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations Section 15301(c); and
- 2) Finds that Granite Construction Company has demonstrated sufficient Good Faith Efforts in an attempt to achieve the Underutilized Disadvantaged Business Enterprise goal of 12% for this project; and
- 3) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Granite Construction Company for the Elk Grove-Florin Pavement Rehabilitation Project in the amount of \$559,447; and
- 4) Authorizes the City Engineer to approve change orders for an amount not to exceed \$84,000.
