

**RESOLUTION NO. 2010-111**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE  
CALLING AND GIVING NOTICE OF PROPOSED ADVISORY MEASURE TO BE  
INCLUDED IN THE CONSOLIDATED GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION OF  
NOVEMBER 2, 2010**

**WHEREAS**, on April 28, 2010, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2010-83 calling for, and giving notice of, a General Municipal Election to be held on November 2, 2010 and requested consolidation of the General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Municipal Election of November 2, 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council also desires to submit to the voters at the election an advisory measure related to the number of council member residency districts.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City Council hereby orders that the following advisory question be submitted to the voters in the City of Elk Grove, California on Tuesday, November 2, 2010:

Section 2. That an advisory measure is to appear on the ballot as follows:

<b>ADVISORY VOTE ONLY</b>	
INCREASE TO A SEVEN MEMBER LEGISLATIVE BODY Shall members of the legislative body of the City of Elk Grove be qualified by and elected from <b>six (6) districts</b> and the Mayor be qualified and elected on a citywide basis by the voters of the entire city; a "Yes" vote increases the legislative body to seven (7) members; a "No" vote retains the current size of the legislative body at five (5) members.	YES

Section 3. The ballots to be used at the election shall be in the form and content as required by law.

Section 4. The polls for the election shall open at 7:00 a.m. on the day of the election and shall remain open continuously from that time until 8:00 p.m. of the same day when the polls shall be closed, except as provided in Section 14401 of the Elections Code.

Section 5. In all particulars not recited in this resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

Section 6. Notice of the time and place of holding the election is hereby given and the City Clerk is hereby authorized, instructed and directed to give further or additional notice of the election in the time, form, and manner required by law.

Section 7. That the City Clerk is directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Registrar of Voters.
