

**RESOLUTION NO. 2011-205**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE  
APPROVING THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE 2011-12  
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) ACTION PLAN  
AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AND FILE  
ALL DOCUMENTS REQUIRED TO RECEIVE US DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING  
AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) CDBG FUNDING**

**WHEREAS**, the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, authorized pursuant to Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended (Act), requires that jurisdictions provide for the issuance of grants in order to attain the objective of providing decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low- and moderate-income; and

**WHEREAS**, due to project cancellation and budget savings, the City has \$239,605.21 in prior-year funds to reallocate to new projects; and

**WHEREAS**, there has been presented to, and reviewed by this City Council, the second amendment to the 2011-12 Action Plan (Action Plan Amendment #2), which describes programs to be funded during the 2011-12 program year using reallocated funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council provided an opportunity for the public to comment on the project options on September 14, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Elk Grove has held, with proper notification and after a mandatory 30-day public comment period, a public hearing on October 26, 2011 to receive comments and proposals from the public regarding the use of CDBG funds.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Approves the adoption of the second amendment to the 2011-12 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Action Plan certifying that that the City of Elk Grove has and will continue to conduct its activities in accordance with applicable statutes and regulations governing the CDBG Program, as identified in the Certifications in Appendix C of the Action Plan; and
- 2) Authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to execute and file the CDBG Action Plan amendment with US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), along with any other documents required to secure the funding.




