**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND \$64,500 FROM THE
TREE PRESERVATION FUND FOR THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
GREENPRINT PROGRAM TREE PLANTINGS**

WHEREAS, Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 19.12.220 establishes a tree preservation fund, officially titled the Tree Preservation Fund; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Tree Preservation Fund is to fund tree planting efforts, tree preservation programs, and public education programs regarding trees; and

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Tree Foundation has presented a proposal to the City to implement native tree planting projects as part of its Native Trees in Urban and Rural Environments (NATURE) Program; and


WHEREAS, the native tree planting projects are consistent with the provisions of the Tree Preservation Fund and the Greenprint program; and

WHEREAS, the native tree planting projects are exempt from California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) review pursuant to Section 15304 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations (State CEQA Guidelines) – Minor Alterations to Land; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove desires to expend tree mitigation funds for the City of Elk Grove Greenprint Program tree plantings.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove authorizes the City Manager, or her designee, to expend \$64,500 from the Tree Preservation Fund for the City of Elk Grove Greenprint Program Tree Plantings.
