A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DISPENSING WITH COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A FIVE-YEAR CONTRACT AMENDMENT WITH SUNGARD PUBLIC SECTOR FOR CITY WIDE SOFTWARE IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$2,459,212 [FOR A TOTAL COMPENSATION AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$5,074,212]

- WHEREAS, the City competitively bid in 2003 for the purchase of City wide software and SunGard was selected through that process, and
- WHEREAS, SunGard Public Sector met all of the criteria in the Request for Proposals (RFP) that was determined the lowest responsive, responsible bidder to the City and was awarded Contract No. C-03-145; and
- WHEREAS, for the reason stated in the accompanying staff report and any additional information presented at the City Council meeting at which this item was heard, the City Council finds that competitive bidding for the subject services is not in the best interests of the City; and
- WHEREAS, Information Technology Services has sufficient funding identified in its Fiscal Year 2012-13 operating budget for this service; and
- WHEREAS, the City has used this software for eight years as their City wide software program to house centralized data for all departments to utilize and wishes to continue using the previously selected software; and
- WHEREAS, SunGard Public Sector will provide that software and service with direction from the City's Information Technology Administrator at a fair and competitive price.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby dispenses with competitive bidding and authorizes the City Manager to execute a five-year contract amendment with SunGard Public Sector for city wide software in an amount not-to-exceed \$2,459,212, for a total compensation amount not-to-exceed \$5,074,212.
