

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-146

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
DISPENSING WITH COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY
MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT #C-12-299
WITH SUTTER MEDICAL FOUNDATION, SUTTER HEALTH SACRAMENTO, AND
SUTTER MEDICAL CENTER FOR POLICE MEDICAL EVIDENTIARY EXAMINATION
SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$150,000**

WHEREAS, evidentiary examinations are critical to the investigation of sexual assaults; and

WHEREAS, law enforcement and medical service providers recognize the benefit to survivors and society of the thorough investigation and successful prosecution of the sexual offender; and

WHEREAS, there must exist a formal agreement between law enforcement and medical providers as to how each will perform its role in the investigatory process of a sexual assault; and


WHEREAS, the Sutter medical group which includes Sutter Medical Foundation, Sutter Health Sacramento, and Sutter Medical Center has provided reliable law enforcement medical evidentiary exams for the Elk Grove Police Department for over seven (7) years; and

WHEREAS, the Sutter medical group possesses the requisite training and certification necessary for evidentiary and laboratory examination to be used in a court of law; and

WHEREAS, for the reasons presented, competitive bidding for these medical evidentiary exam services is not in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby finds that it is in the best interest of the City to dispense with the competitive bidding process and authorizes the City Manager to execute the first amendment to contract #C-12-299 with Sutter Medical Foundation, Sutter Health Sacramento, and Sutter Medical Center for police medical evidentiary examination services in an amount not to exceed \$150,000.
