

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-191

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO SELL OR OTHERWISE DISPOSE
OF SURPLUS CITY PROPERTY IN THE FORM OF 18 PALM TREES**

WHEREAS, in 2014, the City purchased 100 acres of land at the southeast corner of Waterman Road and Grant Line Road; east of Highway 99, south of Grant Line Road identified as "Proposed Sports Complex Property" (Property); and

WHEREAS, the Property was purchased by the City to provide land for a multi-sport/multi-use complex for the City; and

WHEREAS, 18 palms trees are located on the Property; and

WHEREAS, staff has designated the 18 palms trees as surplus, because the trees are not conducive to the future use of the land; and


WHEREAS, Elk Grove Municipal Code Chapter 3.42 specifies the terms and conditions for the disposition of surplus City property; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove desires to dispose of the 18 surplus palm trees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the Finance Director to sell or otherwise dispose of surplus City property in the form of 18 palm trees located on the Property as shown in Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that proceeds from the sale or disposal of the surplus palm trees shall be deposited into the Facilities Fund to offset any future maintenance costs associated with the Property.

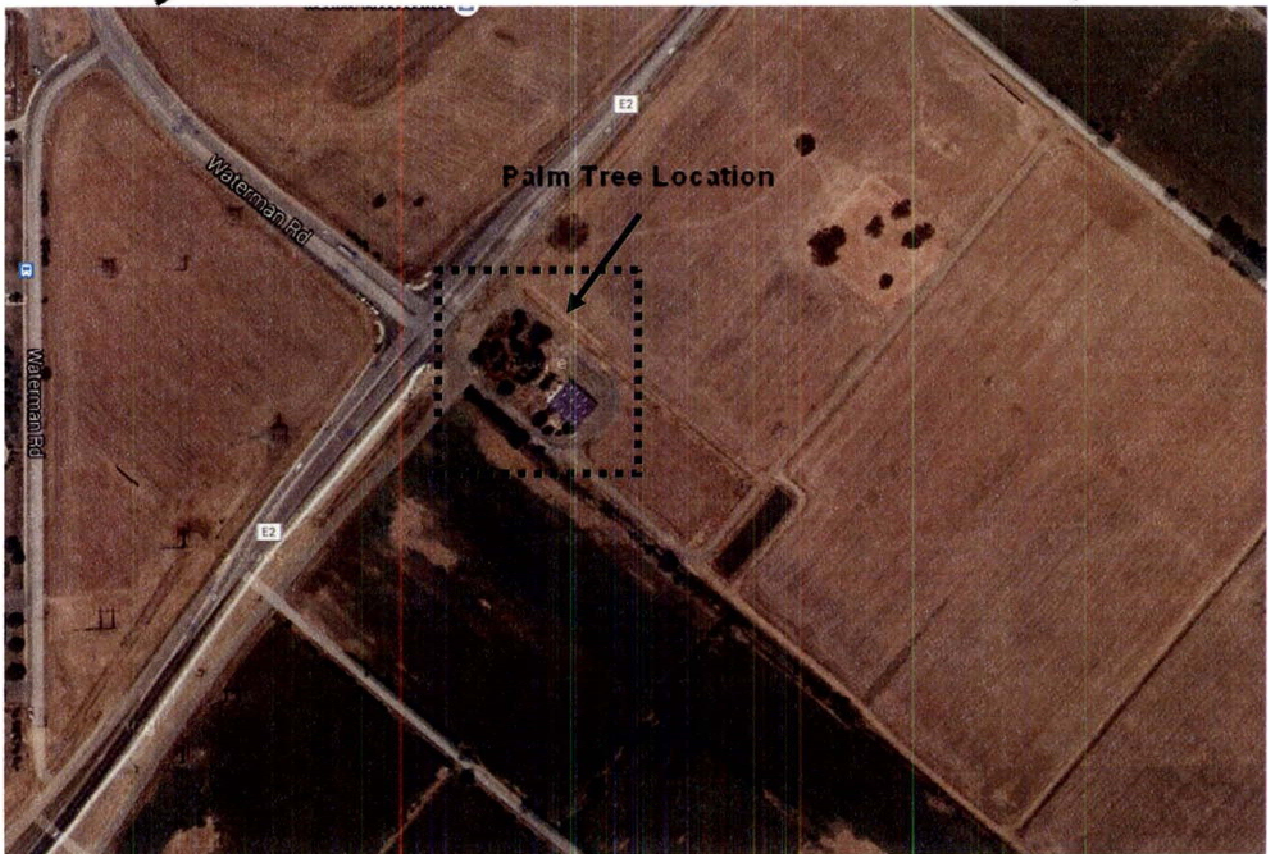
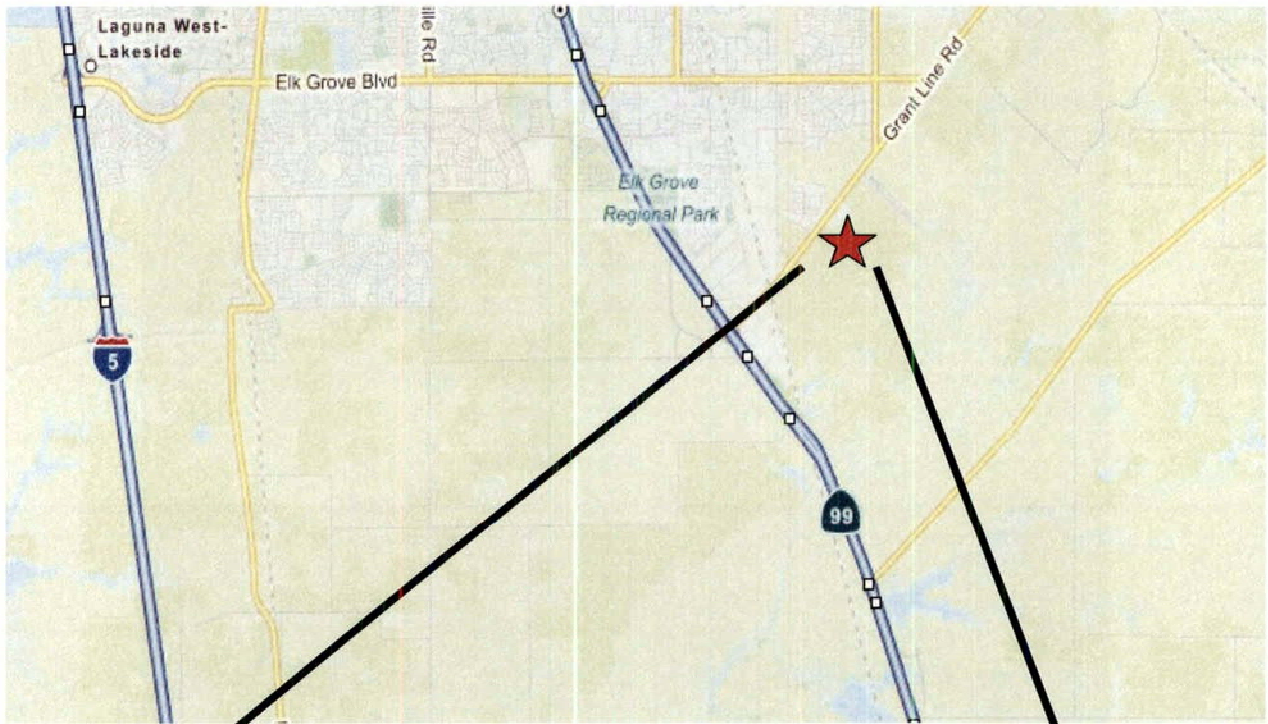


