**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR AND TO EXECUTE THE  
NECESSARY DOCUMENTS FOR A COOPERATIVE WORK AGREEMENT  
EXTENSION BETWEEN THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AND STATE OF CALIFORNIA,  
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, WHICH WILL EXTEND THE PERIOD OF  
TIME TO EXPEND THE FEDERAL GRANT FUNDS FOR THE BRADSHAW  
ROAD/SHELDON ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, CITY  
PROJECT PT0137, FEDERAL PROJECT BRLS-5479(012)**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Elk Grove has undertaken the Bradshaw Road/Sheldon Road Intersection Improvements Project preliminary engineering and environmental document, CIP PT0137 ("Project") to replace a bridge and construct intersection improvements consisting of a traffic signal or roundabout; and

**WHEREAS**, the City applied for and received a federal grant from the State of California, Department of Transportation in 2011 for funding toward preliminary engineering and environmental approval of the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Federal funding will lapse on June 30, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, the California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000 et seq. of the Public Resources Code, herein after CEQA) requires that cities consider the environmental consequences of their actions before approving a project; and

**WHEREAS**, because of the use of federal funding, this project also qualifies for review under the National Environmental Policy Act (42 U.S.C. 4321 et seq, hereinafter NEPA); and


**WHEREAS**, the Project is a project under both CEQA and NEPA, and is currently under environmental review; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Elk Grove can apply for a Cooperative Work Agreement Extension to extend the Federal funding authorization for the project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove or its authorized representative must apply for and sign documents for the Cooperative Work Agreement Extension.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager to apply for and execute the necessary documents for a Cooperative Work Agreement Extension between the City of Elk Grove and Caltrans.
