

**RESOLUTION NO. 2019-010**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE ACCEPTING THE BRADSHAW/SHELDON ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (FEDERAL NUMBER BRLS-5479(012)) (PT0137) AS COMPLETE; AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO PREPARE AND THE CITY CLERK TO FILE THE NOTICE OF COMPLETION WITH THE SACRAMENTO COUNTY RECORDER; AND AUTHORIZING STAFF TO AMEND THE ANNUAL BUDGET AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BY REDUCING THE REMAINING PROJECT BUDGET AUTHORITY TO ZERO AND RETURNING ANY REMAINING FUNDS BACK TO THEIR RESPECTIVE FUND(S), EXCLUDING \$100,000 IN ELK GROVE ROADWAY FEE (FUND 328) FUNDS WHICH WILL REMAIN ON BALANCE TO COVER ENVIRONMENTAL PERMIT REQUIREMENTS THAT EXTEND BEYOND THE CONCLUSION OF CONSTRUCTION**

**WHEREAS**, on March 24, 2018, the City Council authorized the award of a construction contract to Granite Rock Company, for the Bradshaw/Sheldon Road Intersection Improvements Project (Federal Number BRLS-5479(012)) (PT0137); and

**WHEREAS**, the Project included construction to replace the existing bridge and four-way stop at the Sheldon Road and Bradshaw Road intersection with a precast reinforced concrete box culvert and a multi-lane roundabout; and

**WHEREAS**, Granite Rock Company has completed the work in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract documents for the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, if no liens or claims have been filed within thirty-five (35) days of filing the Notice of Completion, the retained payment funds and any remaining amount due will be released to Granite Rock Company; and

**WHEREAS**, post construction work is typically completed within one hundred twenty (120) days of the City Clerk filing the Notice of Completion with the Sacramento County Recorder and then all invoices can be paid; and

**WHEREAS**, non-typical post construction work will need to occur which will include completion of five years of creek monitoring and completion of Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Letter Of Map Revision (LOMR).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Accepts the Bradshaw / Sheldon Road Intersection Improvements Project (Federal Number BRLS-5479(012)) (PT0137) as complete;
- 2) Authorizes the City Engineer to prepare a Notice of Completion and the City Clerk to file the Notice of Completion for the Project with the Sacramento County Recorder; and

- 3) Authorizes staff to amend the Annual Budget and Capital Improvement Program by reducing the remaining project budget authority to zero and returning any remaining funds back to their respective fund(s), excluding \$100,000 in Elk Grove Roadway Fee (Fund 328) funds which will remain on balance to cover environmental permit requirements that extend beyond the conclusion of construction.


