

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-019

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE APPROVING STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION FOR THE PROJECT PRIORITY RANKINGS FOR SACOG'S 2021 REGIONAL FUNDING ROUND

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the six-county Sacramento region and is the transportation planning agency responsible for developing and implementing the long-range transportation plan and allocating federal and state funding for projects to its member agencies; and

WHEREAS, the six-county region includes the counties of El Dorado, Placer, Sacramento, Sutter, Yolo, and Yuba, and the cities within those counties, including the City of Elk Grove (City); and

WHEREAS, SACOG conducts a regional funding round on approximately two-year cycles and the 2021 Funding Round allocates funding from various federal and state sources including the Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP), the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Program, and the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) and these funds are allocated by SACOG through multiple competitive grant programs including the Community Design Program, the Maintenance and Modernization Program, and the Transformative Program, collectively referred to as the Regional Funding Round; and

WHEREAS, SACOG released a call for the 2021 Regional Funding Round on November 11, 2020, and has made several changes from prior funding rounds including a more streamlined application process, the addition of an advanced consultation phase, and a requirement to provide a project priority ranking in certain programs; and

WHEREAS, staff considered 21 potential projects and then met with SACOG staff on December 16, 2020, to discuss a more refined list of 12 projects and based on input from SACOG, staff has narrowed the list to a total of nine projects; and

WHEREAS, staff developed a project priority ranking for eight projects from projects identified in the City's High Priority Project list, prioritizing pavement maintenance and congestion relief, and separate transit needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby approves the project priority rankings as recommended by staff for SACOG's 2021 Regional Funding Round for transportation and transit projects as follows:

Transportation Infrastructure Project Priority Ranking:

1. Kammerer Rd. Phase 1 -Two Lane Extension, I-5 to Bruceville Rd.
2. North Laguna Creek Project
3. Grant Line Rd. and Wilton Rd. Operational Improvements
4. Laguna Creek Inter-Regional Trail Crossing at State Route 99
5. East Stockton Blvd. Pavement Rehab and Complete Streets
6. Elk Grove Blvd. Adaptive Traffic Signal Pilot Project
7. Power Inn Road Safety and Congestion Relief Project

Transit Project Priority Ranking:

1. Replacement Purchase of Six 40-ft. CNG Buses
