**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO CALL FOR BIDS FOR THE
ELK GROVE BOULEVARD REHABILITATION PROJECT**

WHEREAS, rehabilitating the pavement along Elk Grove Boulevard will improve ride quality and extend pavement life; and

WHEREAS, drainage improvements, intelligent transportation conduit placement and sidewalk ramp repair work are included to increase safety, enhance pedestrian accessibility, and reduce long term maintenance needs; and

WHEREAS, improvement designs and construction bid documents have been coordinated with and approved by the State Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, all costs associated with the project will be funded through Federal funds, Measure A Construction Funds, Storm Water Utility Fee Funds, Capital Facilities Fee funds.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Engineer to call for bids for the Elk Grove Boulevard Rehabilitation Project.



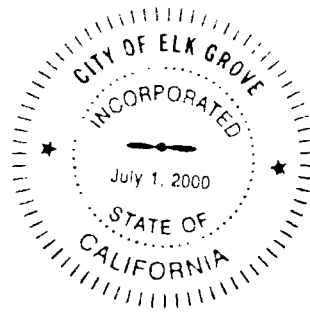
