## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DECLARING CERTAIN CITY-OWNED REAL PROPERTIES TO BE SURPLUS PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTON 54220, ET SEQ (CEQA EXEMPT)

**WHEREAS**, the Surplus Land Act, Government Code Section 54220, et seq., defines surplus property as land owned by any local agency that is not necessary for the agency's use; and

**WHEREAS**, staff has completed a review of City-owned property and has identified certain sites that may not be necessary for the City's use as defined in state law; and

WHEREAS, the passage of this resolution will not cause a direct physical change in the environment, nor a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment; this action, therefore, does not constitute the approval of a project under the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"), and it is exempt from CEQA. (Pub. Res. Code § 21065, CEQA Guidelines §§ 15060(c),(2)(3); 15061(b)(3); 15064(d)(3); 15378(a)).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby declares that the certain City-owned properties, and any rights, title, and interest therein, located at 8663, 8665, and 8675 Kammerer Road (APNs 132-0320-001, -002, and -010) (the "Property") are declared surplus land pursuant to Government Code Section 54220 et seq. based upon the following finding:

Finding: The Property is surplus land.

<u>Evidence</u>: The Property is not currently necessary for the City's use, and is not currently being used or planned to be used pursuant to a written adopted plan adopted by the City Council for agency work or operations, utility sites, conservation land, or qualified educational facilities, as provided for in Government Code Section 54220 et seq.

**AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City Manager or authorized designee is authorized to prepare and send all notices required by state law related to the declaration of the above-identified surplus property including, without limitation, notices of availability of the surplus property as provided for by state law.
