

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-269**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT OFFICE OF COMMUNITY  
ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES GRANT FUNDING FOR THE ELK GROVE  
POLICE DEPARTMENT'S COMMUNICATIONS CENTER RENOVATION FROM THE  
U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE AND AMEND THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S  
BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$520,000**

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) under the Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS Office) provides grant funding opportunities to local law enforcement agencies for technology and equipment community projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the Elk Grove Police Department applied for the grant funding proposing to use the funds for a remodel of the Communications Center and integration of the Real-Time Information Center into the Communications Center for 24/7 coverage; and

**WHEREAS**, the City received notice the application was accepted by DOJ and the City was awarded \$520,000 in grant funding.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager to:

- 1) Accept the awarded COPS Office grant funding, in the amount of \$520,000 from the U.S. Department of Justice and to execute all documents and take all actions reasonably necessary to implement the grant funding; and
- 2) Amend the Police Department's revenue and expense budget equal to the grant award received and expended each fiscal year, beginning with Fiscal Year 2022-2023, until the total grant amount has been received and expended.
