The City has three very low-income units remaining:

• The Aizenberg property was pending sale. The closing was pushed out until October to allow time for the buyer to qualify for CHDAP funding.

 The two Emerald Park units were in the process of being transferred to a nonprofit, Sacramento Self-Help Housing, which will rent them to very low-income persons. SSHH made an offer for the properties and were in the counteroffer process at the end of the quarter. The units are expected to be transferred on or before October 31.
