Overall Progress Narrative:

The City continued to implement the Downpayment Assistance Program (DAP) in Q1 of 2010. The City provided another three loans to first-time homebuyers, and has made five loans to date. The City had approximately eight additional applications in process for the remaining nine loans available, and is on track to expend most of it&rsquos DAP funds by the end of Q2. The City is on track to fully expend the DAP funds by September 2010. We anticipate a total of 14 downpayment loans made under the DAP.

The City selected Mission Housing as a consultant for the City&rsquos NSP Very Low-Income Housing Acquisition and Rehabilitation Program. The program aims to acquire and lease/rent six affordable housing units to very low-income households. The City continued to work with Mission Housing to draft the consultant agreement, and will fully execute the contract and begin implementing the program by the beginning of Q2. The City intends to work aggressively to obligate nearly all of these funds by the end of Q2.

Finally, the City reviewed the three responses received for the RFP for the Affordable Housing Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resale Program. The program will provide up to \$1,000,000 for the acquisition, rehabilitation, and resale of eight or more affordable housing units with deed restrictions to assure continued affordability for 30 years. City staff is prepared to make their recommendation to the City Council in beginning of Q2; and will promptly move forward with contract negotiations and execution thereafter so that the City and consultant(s) can begin to implement the program in a timely manner.

The City has a monitoring visit scheduled for the beginning of Q2, and will be visited by our HUD representative and a NSP specialist. The City anticipates this visit will be very productive and will help the City to make positive and aggressive steps toward fully obligating its funds by the September 30, 2010 deadline. The City looks forward to reporting on the many successes and milestones achieved in Q2 and beyond.
