Subject: Road Closure Moratorium for Regional San's Elk Grove Transmission Line Project

Regional San will be installing a transmission pipeline along Franklin Boulevard from Sims Road to Whitelock Parkway and along Willard Parkway from Whitelock Parkway to Matina Drive. The City of Elk Grove will institute a construction moratorium on selected City streets from May 2024 through March 2026. Unless specifically approved by the Public Works Director or his designee, all construction activities that interfere with public traffic on specific City streets (see enclosed table and map) will be restricted. Construction activities pertaining to these specific streets shall be completed prior to the moratorium or postponed. To request an exception from Public Works Director, contact the Permits Engineer at PWPermits@elkgrovecity.org for Public Works Permits or Steven Liu at SLiu@elkgrovecity.org for Development Projects.

Emergency repairs will be allowed, as set forth in Section 7-8.06 of the Standard Construction Specifications. Please send emergency work notifications to PWPermits@elkgrovecity.org and contact Naweed Ataie, Public Works Inspector, regarding repairs within one hour of your start time at: (916) 627-3422 and/or NAtaie@elkgrovecity.org.

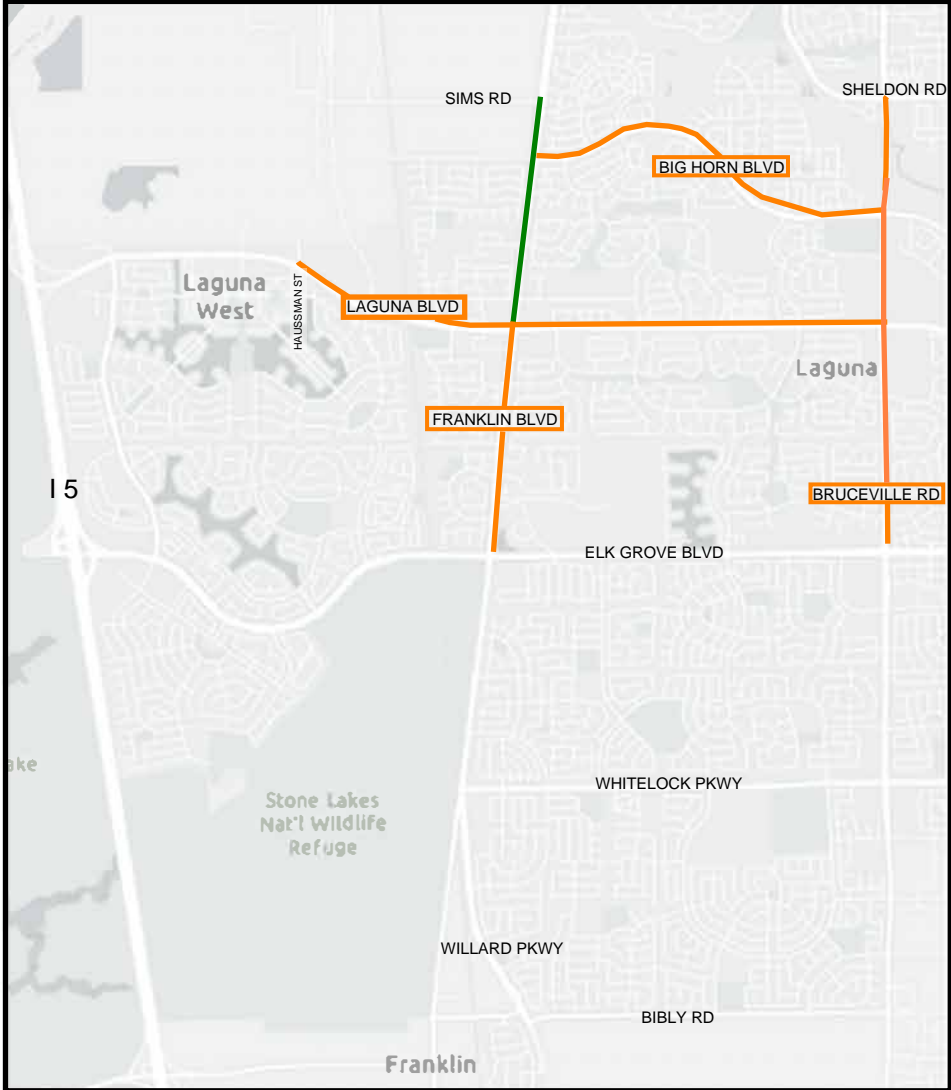

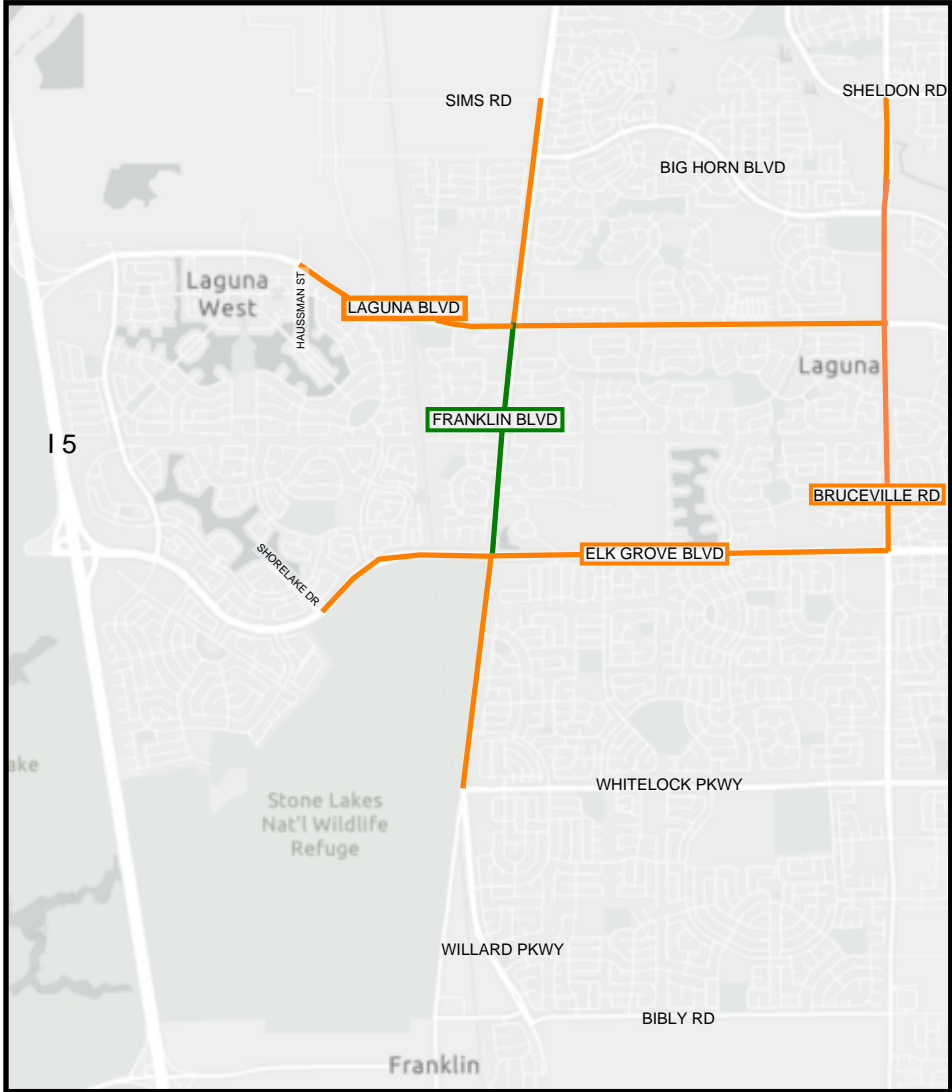


REGIONAL SAN ELK GROVE TRANSMISSION PIPELINE STREET MORATORIUM - PHASE TWO

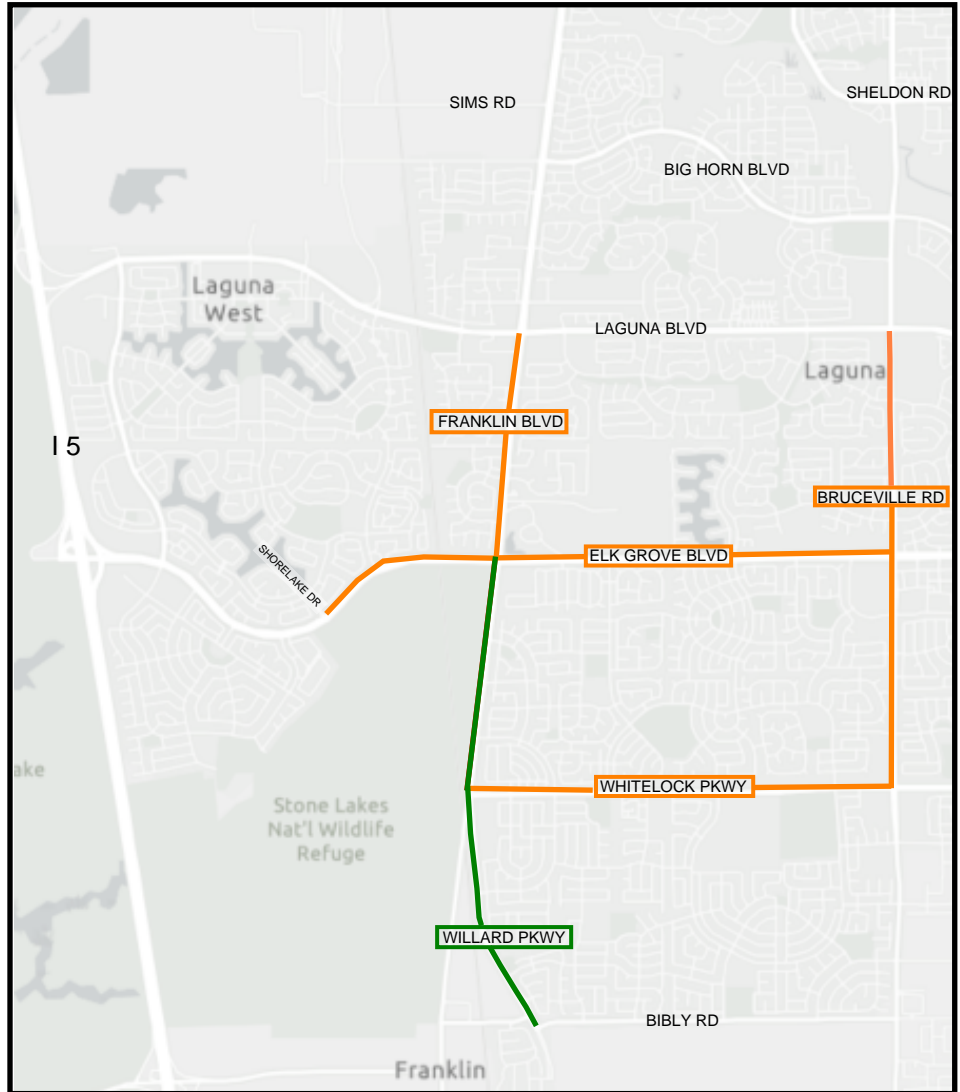


REGIONAL SAN ELK GROVE TRANSMISSION PIPELINE STREET MORATORIUM - PHASE THREE
