**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO CALL FOR BIDS FOR THE
LAGUNA GATEWAY LANDSCAPING PROJECT AT STATE ROUTE 99 AND
LAGUNA/BOND ROAD INTERCHANGE**

WHEREAS, landscape improvements to the above-referenced interchange will enhance the existing landscaping and irrigation system within the State's right of way; and

WHEREAS, improvement designs have been coordinated with and approved by the State Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, all costs associated with the project will be funded through Federal funds, and the Laguna and Elk Grove Roadway Fee Programs.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Engineer to call for bids for the Laguna Gateway Landscaping Project at State Route 99 and Laguna/Bond Road Interchange.


