**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO CALL FOR BIDS FOR THE
INTERSECTION OF GRANT LINE ROAD AND EAST STOCKTON BOULEVARD
TRAFFIC SIGNAL PROJECT**

WHEREAS, there is an immediate need for traffic congestion relief at the intersection of Grant Line Road and East Stockton Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the proposed East Stockton Boulevard/Grant Line Road Intersection Improvement Project (the "Project") will ease congestion being experienced at the intersection until the Grant Line Road / State Route 99 Interchange Reconstruction Project is completed; and

WHEREAS, all project costs will be funded by the Elk Grove Roadway Fee Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorize the City Engineer to call for bids for the Intersection of Grant Line Road and East Stockton Boulevard Traffic Signal Project.




