

**RESOLUTION NO. 2005-129**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE A NEW  
AT-GRADE PUBLIC ROAD CROSSING AGREEMENT FOR RECONSTRUCTION,  
WIDENING, MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF THE EXISTING BOND ROAD AT-  
GRADE PUBLIC ROAD CROSSING BETWEEN THE UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD  
COMPANY AND THE CITY OF ELK GROVE**

**WHEREAS**, improving and widening Bond Road holds a high priority in the City of Elk Grove Transportation Improvement Program; and


**WHEREAS**, improving and widening the Bond Road at-grade crossing of the Union Pacific Railroad is an important part of the widening of Bond Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Engineer and the California Public Utilities Commission have approved the project plans, specifications and costs for improving and widening the Bond Road at-grade crossing of the Union Pacific Railroad; and


**WHEREAS**, the costs for improving and widening the Bond Road at-grade crossing of the Union Pacific Railroad will be funded by the Elk Grove Roadway Fee Program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager, or his designee, to execute a new at-grade public road crossing agreement for reconstruction, widening, maintenance and operation of the existing Bond Road at-grade public road crossing between the Union Pacific Railroad Company and the City of Elk Grove.


