WHEREAS, areas throughout the City, including several major arterial roadways, have been identified as candidates for further commuter service coverage; and

WHEREAS, portions of existing commuter routes may be expanded or altered to provide additional coverage and more efficient travel.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the proposed expansion and modification of transit commuter service as described in the staff report of May 11, 2005 and approved by the City Council, effective June 19, 2005.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the City Council of the City of Elk Grove this 11th day of May 2005.




