SIDEWALK, CURB AND GUTTER IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**


WHEREAS, the Laguna Boulevard Overcrossing of the Union Pacific Railroad Sidewalk, Curb and Gutter Improvements Project will enhance safety for pedestrians using wheel chairs and eliminate potential tripping hazards; and

WHEREAS, the City Council authorized the City Engineer to call for bids on the project on December 14, 2005; and

WHEREAS, staff has determined Vanguard Construction, Inc. to be the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.




