

**RESOLUTION NO. 2008-117**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR  
ACCESS TO SACRAMENTO COUNTY CLETS/CJIS APPLICATIONS WITH THE  
COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO, FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$55,464**

**WHEREAS**, on April 27, 2005, the City Council took action to notice Sacramento County with an intent to cancel its contract for police services, thereby establishing an 18-month timeline to create a municipal police department; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 26, 2006, the City Council approved Resolution 2006-88 authorizing the City Manager or designee to execute the Agreement for Access to Sacramento County CLETS/CJIS Applications with the County of Sacramento; and

**WHEREAS**, full access to the California Law Enforcement Teletype System (CLETS) and the Criminal Justice Information System (CJIS) is essential to the routine completion of tasks by police personnel; and

**WHEREAS**, Sacramento County and the Office of Communications and Information Technology (OCIT) maintain access allowing agencies to access these data bases; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council recognizes the need for law enforcement personnel to access criminal justice and law enforcement data bases.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove authorizes the City Manager or designee to execute an Agreement for Access to Sacramento County CLETS/CJIS Applications with the County of Sacramento, for an amount not to exceed \$55,464.


