

RESOLUTION NO. 2008-114

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$46,352.40 WITH CAL SIERRA CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE ELK GROVE ELEMENTARY SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, A PROJECT COMPONENT OF THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL—LAGUNA CREEK TRAIL BRIDGE AND ASSOCIATED IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS NOT TO EXCEED \$6,950

WHEREAS, Caltrans awarded to the City of Elk Grove a Safe Routes To School Grant for the Laguna Creek Trail Bridge and Associated Improvements Project (Project) (Capital Improvement Project ID PT0065); and

WHEREAS, this Project is identified in the City's Capital Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, this Project will improve student access to Elk Grove Elementary School and involves constructing a bridge across Laguna Creek as well as safety improvements at Elk Grove Elementary School (School); and

WHEREAS, the existing pavement delineation on Colliston Drive and Crowell Drive adjacent to the Elk Grove Elementary School and pedestrian crossing in front of the School on Crowell Drive can be improved to enhance safety; and

WHEREAS, the new improvements were developed in cooperation with the School District and the Fallbrook Neighborhood Association; and

WHEREAS, construction bid documents reflect improvements desired by the School District and community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove plans to deliver the Elk Grove Elementary School Safety Improvements Project as a separate construction contract from the Laguna Creek Bridge construction contract; and

WHEREAS, an invitation to bid was duly advertised, bids were opened on Tuesday, April 29, 2008 and Cal Sierra Construction, Inc. was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid; and


WHEREAS, California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (CEQA Guidelines Section 15301) provides that no environmental review document is required where the Project consists only of minor expansion of existing public facilities with little or no change in use; and

WHEREAS, this Project is limited to minor alterations of existing pavement and sidewalk to accommodate pedestrians.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

1. Finds that the Project is exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines Section 15301;
2. Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract in the amount of \$46,352.40 with Cal Sierra Construction, Inc. for the Elk Grove Elementary Safety Improvements Project, a project component of the Safe Routes to School-Laguna Creek Trail Bridge and Associated Improvements Project;
3. Authorizes the City Engineer to approve change orders not to exceed \$6,950; and
4. Directs staff to file a Notice of Exemption with the County.
