

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-11

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
APPROVING IDENTIFIED STREETS FOR SPEED CONTROL MEASURES AND
DIRECTING STAFF TO PROCEED WITH DESIGN**

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove wishes to manage residential street speeds utilizing a systematic approach for the entire City; and

WHEREAS, the City has adopted a Speed Control Program which contains guidelines to qualify and prioritize streets for installation of speed control devices; and

WHEREAS, the City has balloted residents on qualified streets to ensure their support of the traffic calming devices; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic Safety Committee has recommended the installation of speed control measures; and


WHEREAS, the residents on the following streets have returned at least 50 percent of the ballots and two-thirds of the returned ballots are in support of the proposed traffic calming devices.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Finds that the proposed implementation of traffic calming devices is exempt from environmental review pursuant to Section 15301(c) of the California Environmental Quality Act guidelines, which allows for the alteration of existing public facilities, including streets, for the purpose of public safety;
- 2) Approves the streets identified above for the design of speed control measures; and
- 3) Directs staff to proceed with design and preparation of construction documents for speed control devices on the identified streets within Council approved budgeted funds in the Capital Improvement Program and the adopted budget.


