

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-61

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
DISPENSING WITH COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY
MANAGER TO EXECUTE A THREE-YEAR CONTRACT AMENDMENT WITH
FASTER ASSET SOLUTIONS FOR FLEET SOFTWARE SERVICES, WITH AN
OPTION OF ONE, TWO-YEAR EXTENSION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED
\$56,305 [FOR A TOTAL NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$157,005]**

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove's Fleet division maintains City vehicles including mechanical, structural and aesthetic standards; and

WHEREAS, a software database is required to accurately track expenditures such as acquisition, preventative maintenance, repair, fueling, depreciation and disposal; and

WHEREAS, in October of 2005 the City conducted a Request for Quotations (RFQ) to seek economies of scale and thereby complied with the competitive bid requirements within the City's contracts and purchasing ordinance; and

WHEREAS, CCG Systems, Inc., dba FASTER Asset Solutions met all of the criteria in the RFQ that was determined the lowest responsive, responsible bidder to the City and was awarded Contract no. C-06-125; and


WHEREAS, for the reason stated in the accompanying staff report and any additional information presented at the City Council meeting at which this item was heard, the City Council finds that competitive bidding for the subject services is not in the best interests of the City; and

WHEREAS, Transit Services has a requirement to track Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) and unleaded gasoline expenditures. FASTER Asset Solutions offers the same fuel module that interfaces with the Clean Energy card lock facility as the module utilized by Fleet Services. This additional service is included in the \$11,225; and

WHEREAS, Fleet and Transit Services has sufficient funding identified in its Fiscal Year 2011-12 operating budget for this service.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby dispenses with competitive bidding for Fleet software services and authorizes the City Manager to amend current Contract No. C-06-125 to include an additional fuel module to support Transit fueling and execute a three-year contract amendment with FASTER Asset Solutions for Fleet software services with an option of one, two-year extension in an amount not-to-exceed \$56,305 *[for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$157,005]*.
