

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-135

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO WAIVE COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH WONDRIES FLEET GROUP OF ALHAMBRA FOR THE PURCHASE OF THREE POLICE PATROL UNITS IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED A TOTAL OF \$84,100 AND AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE WHEN NECESSARY UP TO THREE ADDITIONAL VEHICLES IN A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$168,100

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove's Fleet division maintains all City vehicles and procures replacements when necessary; and

WHEREAS, the City's Fleet division has identified three patrol vehicles that have reached their useful life and require replacement; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Chapter 3.42, the City Council may waive the competitive bidding process when the purchase is processed through a cooperative purchasing agreement with another public agency whose procurement process is consistent with the City of Elk Grove; and


WHEREAS, the County of Los Angeles opened a competitive bidding process for the purchase of police patrol vehicles and Wondries Fleet Group of Alhambra met all of the criteria and was selected as the lowest responsive responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, Fleet Services has sufficient funding identified in its 2012-13 fiscal year operating budget for this purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby waives the competitive bidding process for a contract with Wondries Fleet Group because of the availability of patrol vehicles of the same specifications currently used by the Elk Grove Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Wondries Fleet Group of Alhambra for the purchase of three police patrol vehicles in an amount not-to-exceed \$84,100 and provide the City Manager authority to purchase three additional patrol vehicles when necessary during Fiscal Year 2012-13 in a total amount not-to-exceed \$168,100.
