

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-230

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE ACCEPTING THE ELK GROVE HISTORIC CONTEXT STATEMENT AS A VALUABLE RESOURCE TOOL FOR HISTORIC PRESERVATION

WHEREAS, historic context statements provide the foundation for preservation planning and are critical for understanding, identifying, and evaluating historic resources; and

WHEREAS, in July 2011, the City of Elk Grove was awarded a Certified Local Government grant in the amount of \$22,500 from the State Historic Preservation Office for the development of a historic context statement; and

WHEREAS, the City contributed an additional amount of \$17,380 in historic preservation funds for the purpose of increasing the project budget to a total of \$39,880 for the development of a comprehensive citywide historic context statement; and

WHEREAS, a Request for Proposals for the Elk Grove Historic Context Statement Project was released in September 2011, and the consulting firm Page & Turnbull was selected and hired to prepare the Elk Grove Historic Context Statement; and

WHEREAS, Page & Turnbull has completed the Elk Grove Historic Context Statement, which included input received from two separate public meetings and the Historic Preservation Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Elk Grove Historic Context Statement provides a background on the historic themes related to the development of Elk Grove, identifies associated property types and their character-defining features, provides a framework for evaluating potential historic resources, and fostering the integration of historic preservation into future land use planning and permitting; and


WHEREAS, the Elk Grove Historic Context Statement will also assist in promoting the goals and policies of the City's General Plan Historic Resources Element and supplement Chapter 7 of the Elk Grove Municipal Code (Historic Preservation); and

WHEREAS, it is recognized from time to time that the Elk Grove Historic Context Statement will require updates in order to remain current with the latest available information and the addition of new property surveys; and

WHEREAS, in September 2012, the State Office of Historic Preservation accepted the Elk Grove Historic Context Statement in its entirety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby accepts the Elk Grove Historic Context Statement as a valuable resource tool for historic preservation.
