**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR AND TO EXECUTE THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS FOR A COOPERATIVE WORK AGREEMENT EXTENSION BETWEEN THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AND STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (CALTRANS), WHICH WILL EXTEND THE PERIOD OF TIME TO EXPEND THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL GRANT FUNDS FOR THE LAGUNA CREEK-CAMDEN TRAIL SOUTH, CITY PROJECT PT0121, STATE PROJECT SR2SL-5479(036)**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Elk Grove has undertaken the Laguna Creek Trail – Camden South Spur Project, CIP PT0121 (“Project”) to construct a trail connection from the west end of the existing trail in Camden Park to Bond Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the City applied for and received a grant from the State of California, Department of Transportation in 2011 for Safe Routes to School (SR2S) funding toward construction of the Project; and


**WHEREAS**, the SR2S funding will lapse on June 30, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Elk Grove can apply for a Cooperative Work Agreement Extension to extend the State funding authorization for the project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove or its authorized representative must apply for and sign documents for the Cooperative Work Agreement Extension.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager to apply for and execute the necessary documents for a Cooperative Work Agreement Extension between the City of Elk Grove and Caltrans.


