

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-197

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE FINDING THAT THE WEST STOCKTON BOULEVARD SIDEWALK AND DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (PD0008) IS EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH SIERRA NATIONAL CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$567,669.27 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS NOT-TO-EXCEED \$85,150; AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH THE SECOND LOWEST BIDDER, ALL-AMERICAN CONSTRUCTION, INC, IF SIERRA NATIONAL CONSTRUCTION, INC., DOES NOT MEET FILING OBLIGATIONS

WHEREAS, the West Stockton Boulevard Sidewalk and Drainage Improvements Project (PD0008) (the "Project") will construct frontage improvements at four sites along West Stockton Boulevard and Red Fox Way, where no sidewalk currently exists. The Project also includes road widening/paving, curb, gutter, sidewalk, storm drainpipes and inlets, slurry seal and restriping; and

WHEREAS, the Project is included in the approved Fiscal Year 2015-20 Capital Improvement Program and are budgeted with funds in the approved Fiscal Year 2015-16 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Section 21000 et seq. of the Public Resources Code, hereinafter referred to as CEQA) requires that cities consider the environmental consequences of their actions before approving a project; and

WHEREAS, the Project is a project under CEQA; and

WHEREAS, an invitation to bid was duly advertised on September 2, 2015 and September 9, 2015, and bids were opened on September 15, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Sierra National Construction, Inc. was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby finds this project exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301.

Finding: The proposed Project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to section 15301 of the State CEQA Guidelines.


Evidence: The propose Project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities). The exemption applies to the minor alteration of existing public or private facilities when the alteration involves negligible or no expansion of existing use. The project consists of constructing improved pedestrian access and drainage measures along the western side of West Stockton Boulevard from 500 feet south of Laguna Palms Way to the cul-de-sac south of Red Fox Way and the southern side of Red Fox Way from West Stockton Boulevard to approximately 250

feet west. The Project will also construct road widening/pavement, curb, gutter, sidewalk, slurry seal and restriping. No special circumstances exist that would create a reasonable possibility that the proposed project will have a significant adverse effect on the environment. Therefore, this project qualifies for the identified exemption and no further environmental review is required.

AND BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Sierra National Construction, Inc. for the West Stockton Boulevard Sidewalk and Drainage Improvements Project (PD0008), in the amount of \$567,669.27. upon receipt of all required bonds and insurance and the approval of such bonds and insurance by the City Attorney;
- 2) Authorizes the City Engineer to approve change orders not-to-exceed \$85,150; and
- 3) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with the second lowest bidder, All-American Construction, Inc., in the amount \$626,206.30 upon receipt of all required bonds and insurance and the approval of such bonds and insurance by the City Attorney if Sierra National Construction, Inc. does not meet filing obligations and authorizes the City Engineer to approve change orders not-to-exceed \$65,986.




