A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH R.A. NEMETZ CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC. FOR THE BRIDGE PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE PROJECT (WBR001) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$214,303.50; AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS NOT-TO-EXCEED \$21,430

- WHEREAS, the Bridge Preventative Maintenance Project (WBR001) shall consist of methacrylate bridge deck treatment on two bridges, joint seal replacement on two bridges, and erosion protection damage mitigation on one bridge (Work); and
- WHEREAS, the Project is included in the approved Fiscal Year 2016-21 Capital Improvement Program and is budgeted with funds in the approved Fiscal Year 2016-17 Budget; and
- WHEREAS, the Project is a project under California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000 et seq. of the Public Resources Code, hereinafter referred to as CEQA) and the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA); and
- WHEREAS, the Project was determined to be exempted under CEQA on May 22, 2015 and NEPA on October 5, 2015; and
- WHEREAS, an invitation to bid was duly advertised on August 3, 2016 and August 10, 2016 and bids were opened on August 25, 2016; and
- WHEREAS, T P A Construction, Inc. was the apparent low bidder determined to be non-responsive as they did not meet the established Project Disadvantage Enterprise (DBE) goal and did not submit a valid Good Faith Effort; and
- **WHEREAS**, R.A. Nemetz Construction Company, Inc. was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:
 - Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with R.A. Nemetz Construction Company, Inc. for the Bridge Preventative Maintenance Project (WBR001) in the amount of \$214,303.50 upon receipt of all required bonds and insurance and the approval of such bonds and insurance by the City Attorney; and
 - 2) Authorizes the City Engineer to approve change orders not-to-exceed \$21,430; and
 - 3) Rejects the bid received by T.P.A. Construction, Inc. for this Project.
