

**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-008**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE  
AUTHORIZING THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO SELL OR OTHERWISE  
DISPOSE OF SURPLUS CITY PROPERTY IN THE FORM OF  
LAW ENFORCEMENT VEHICLES, A CITY VEHICLE AND TRAILER,  
LAW ENFORCEMENT EQUIPMENT, AND TRANSIT BUSES**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Elk Grove purchased vehicles to be utilized by the Elk Grove Police Department in the normal course of their duties; and

**WHEREAS**, the City purchased used vehicles to be utilized by the City's Transit Division in order to maintain service levels; and

**WHEREAS**, the City received a vehicle and trailer to be utilized by the Elk Grove Police Department for demonstration purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, staff has designated; seven law enforcement vehicles as surplus, as they have reached the end of their service life based on years in service, high mileage, and/or frequency/cost of repairs, and collision damage, and four transit buses as surplus as they have reached the end of their service life based on CNG tank expiration or engine failure, and one vehicle and trailer which are no longer utilized by the Elk Grove Police Department for demonstration purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, the law enforcement vehicles are equipped with emergency response equipment that shall be removed prior to any public sale; and

**WHEREAS**, Elk Grove Municipal Code Chapter 3.42 specifies the terms and conditions for the disposition of surplus City property; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Elk Grove desires to surplus seven law enforcement vehicles, their emergency response equipment, four transit buses, and one vehicle and trailer, and sell at fair market value or otherwise dispose of the assets.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the Finance Director to exercise the sale or disposal of surplus City property in the form of seven law enforcement vehicles, four transit buses, one vehicle and trailer including the disposal of any associated emergency response equipment through sale to other law enforcement agencies, reuse by the City, or designated as unsalvageable, based on the needs of the City. The description of these items is shown in Exhibit A to this resolution, incorporated herein by this reference.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that proceeds from any sale or disposal of the surplus vehicles shall be deposited into the Facilities and Fleet Internal Services Fund and Transit Fund, respectively.


