

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-185

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCEDURE PURSUANT TO ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.180(B)(3) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NO. C-22-045 WITH R.C.A. INVESTMENTS, INC., A CALIFORNIA CORPORATION DBA LONG BEACH BMW MOTORCYCLES TO ADD THE PURCHASE OF THREE ADDITIONAL AND ONE REPLACEMENT MOTORCYCLES TO THE CONTRACT IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$184,000 [FOR A TOTAL EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS OVER THE TERM OF THE CONTRACT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$533,000]

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove's Fleet division maintains all City vehicles and procures additional and replacements when necessary; and

WHEREAS, in November of 2022 Elk Grove voters approved Measure E, enacting locally controlled funding to help address services the community identified as important including reducing crime, addressing homelessness, improving 911, police, fire, and emergency disaster and medical response, and enhancing programs to combat youth crime and gang prevention; and

WHEREAS, the Elk Grove Police Department identified the need to add two officer positions to the Traffic Division. The two identified officer positions require pursuit-rated motorcycles. A third motorcycle is required to be available, to keep a favorable spare ratio for the Traffic Division; and

WHEREAS, the one replacement motorcycle requested (#286) was damaged during a training exercise last fiscal year and was determined a total loss requiring replacement at this time; and

WHEREAS, in January 2022, the City Council awarded contract C-22-045 to RCA Investments, Inc., a California Corporation dba Long Beach BMW Motorcycles for three replacement motorcycles; and

WHEREAS, in July 2022, the City Council awarded the first contract amendment, C-22-439 to RCA Investments, Inc. dba Long Beach BMW Motorcycles for three replacement motorcycles; and

WHEREAS, in January 2023, the City Council awarded the second contract amendment, C-23-036 to RCA Investments, Inc. dba Long Beach BMW Motorcycles for three replacement motorcycles; and

WHEREAS, the State of California conducted a competitive bidding process for the purchase of police pursuit-rated motorcycles; and

WHEREAS, R.C.A. Investments Inc., a California Corporation dba Long Beach BMW Motorcycles was awarded the State of California's large quantity contract for pursuit-rated motorcycles, which was competitively bid, thus the City is receiving a competitive price and the expenditures of staff time and money to compile the necessary bid documents for a small number of motorcycles will not likely result in a better price or an outcome more advantageous to the City; and

WHEREAS, there is sufficient funding identified in the Fiscal Year 2023-24 operating budgets for this purchase; and

WHEREAS, for the reasons presented, pursuit of the formal bidding procedure for the proposed purchase is not in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby determines that formal competitive bidding is not in the best interest of the City for the subject motorcycles and hereby dispenses with the formal bidding procedure pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.180(B)(3); and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute an amendment to Contract No. C-22-045 with R.C.A. Investments Inc., a California Corporation dba Long Beach BMW Motorcycles, in substantially the form presented, to add the purchase of three additional and one replacement BMW police pursuit-rated motorcycles for a total purchase of twelve motorcycles, authorizing an additional expenditure of funds not-to-exceed \$184,000 *[for a total expenditure of funds over the term of the contract not-to-exceed \$533,000]*.
