



CITY OF ELK GROVE ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR PLANNING COMMISSION

The City of Elk Grove encourages residents with community planning interests to apply for an appointment consideration to the Planning Commission.

Qualifications: Applicants must be at least 18 years of age, reside in the City of Elk Grove and be registered to vote. Members may not be an officer or employee of the City. Members may not be an elected or appointed official of another public entity whose jurisdiction includes any portion of the City.

Specific Tasks or Objectives: The Elk Grove Planning Commission consists of five members appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the City Council. The Planning Commission considers and advises the City Council on General Plan amendments, and hears matters related to zoning regulations, development proposals, and other matters as specified in the Planning and Zoning Law, and as directed by the City Council.

Appointment and Term: The appointment will be made by Mayor Bobbie Singh-Allen, with the approval of the City Council. Member appointments are reviewed by the Mayor and City Council annually. Appointees will be required to take an Oath of Allegiance and disclose personal assets and interests as required by the Political Reform Act.

The Planning Commission normally meets on the first and third Thursday of every month at 6:00 p.m. in the City Council Chamber at 8400 Laguna Palms Way, Elk Grove.

APPLICATIONS: A Fact Sheet and application are available at the Office of the City Clerk, 8401 Laguna Palms Way, Elk Grove, California 95758 and are posted on the City's website at www.elkgrovecity.org. Current members of the Planning Commission are being encouraged to re-submit an application for consideration. Applications may be mailed or hand-delivered to the Office of the City Clerk.

The deadline to submit an application is February 3, 2021 or until such time as sufficient applications have been received.
