## A Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generators (CESQG)

PROGRAM OFFERS QUALIFYING BUSINESSES A LEGAL AND AFFORDABLE MEANS TO DISPOSE OF THEIR HAZARDOUS WASTE.

### Does my business qualify as a CESQG?

IN ORDER TO QUALIFY AS A CESQG, YOUR BUSINESS CAN GENERATE UP TO (PER MONTH):

- Less than 220 pounds (Approximately 27 gallons of liquid) of most hazardous chemicals
- Less than 2.2 pounds (Approximately 1 quart of liquid) of certain original unused products; e.g. acutely hazardous wastes.
- Less than 110 pounds (Approximately 13 gallons of liquid) of perchloroethylene per month.

*Safety Data Sheets are typically the best source of information regarding the products your business uses, and are available through your product suppliers.*

### Benefits of Being a CESQG Business

BUSINESSES THAT QUALIFY FOR THE CESQG ENJOY:

- A low-cost way to safely and legally dispose of hazardous materials.
- Documentation that your business has properly managed its hazardous waste.
- Consultation from hazardous waste specialists about disposal.
- Additional protection under the "cradle to grave" laws, which states that your business is responsible for the waste it generates. These laws hold businesses liable long after they have paid someone to haul the waste away.



### How should I transport it?

#### ACCEPTABLE AMOUNTS OF WASTE TO TRANSPORT

State law limits the total amount a business can transport to 27 gallons (or 220 pounds) per month, but not more than 100 kg/month. The following acceptance requirements must be met by prior to CESQG's transport:

- CESQG must transport their own waste.
- CESQG or its employee must transport hazardous waste in vehicles owned & operated by the CESQG.
- CESQG must obtain prior approval from SWCC staff before arriving.
- The SWCC Staff shall provide either oral, written or electronic instruction to each CESQG prior to each delivery on proper packaging of waste for safe transportation.
- The SWCC staff shall record all CESQG waste types and present receipts.
- All CESQG waste must be labeled and packaged in sturdy, non-leaking containers.
- Waste shall be transported in closed containers and packed in a manner that prevents containers from tipping, spilling, or breakage during transportation.
- Different CESQG wastes shall not be mixed within a container before or during transportation.
- For extremely or acutely HWs, the total amount of waste a CESQG shall transport is limited to 2.2 lbs.

### HOW MUCH HAZARDOUS MATERIAL CAN MY BUSINESS GENERATE PER MONTH AND STILL QUALIFY?

- Less than 220 pounds (Approximately 27 gallons of liquid) of most hazardous chemicals.
- Less than 2.2 pounds (Approximately 1 quart of liquid) of certain original unused products, e.g. acutely hazardous wastes.
- Less than 110 pounds (Approximately 13 gallons of liquid), of perchloroethylene per month.

### CAN I STORE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS?

A CESQG with less than 100 kilograms (220 pounds or 27 gallons of liquid) may store their hazardous waste. Once 100 kg of waste is accumulated, it may be stored for up to 90 days. After 90 days, you must then send your waste to a licensed recycling or disposal facility (California Health and Safety Code, Section 25123.3).
