

Who is allowed to haul trash and/or recyclables in the City of Elk Grove?

Republic Services has the **exclusive** right to haul trash and recyclables from residential properties in Elk Grove. There are a number of exceptions to this, including self-haul, roll-off box/bin service, and donated items. See the chart on the other side for exceptions.

Only registered commercial haulers can provide trash services at commercial properties in the City, which includes businesses, multi-family properties, and construction or demolition sites. Recycling services can only be provided by one of the registered commercial haulers or one of the county-authorized recyclers. See the chart on the other side for exceptions.

Is a business license all I need to start hauling in the City?

No. If your office is located in Elk Grove, you do need a business license. But, only Republic Services can provide hauling services at residences in the City, with some exceptions. For commercial services, you need authorization from the City to be a registered commercial hauler, which requires an application, proof of insurances, monthly revenue reports, quarterly revenue and tonnage reports, and payment of monthly hauler fees. Why are the requirements so strict?

The City has an obligation to protect public health and safety, to fulfill its contractual obligations to the franchised residential hauler (Republic Services), to maintain a fair and consistent set of requirements for all commercial haulers, to promote safe and efficient transportation of solid waste and to ensure that materials are disposed of properly, to encourage increased recycling, and to prevent illegal dumping .

Trash & Recycling Services in Elk Grove



RESIDENCE

(single family residential, two plex, three plex, or four plex)

Republic Services has the exclusive right to all residential trash and recycling

EXCEPTIONS:

Self-Haul

Items for Donation

Hired Contractor, Handyman or Gardener can haul only the trash they generate during their work

Stores Selling Retail Furnishings

can haul away the old carpet, cabinets, mattresses, furniture, appliances, etc., when delivering the new furnishings

Roll-Off Box/Bin Service

can be provided by one of the registered commercial haulers

Foreclosed Properties (when Bank-Owned)

service can be provided by one of the registered commercial haulers



MULTI-FAMILY

(five plex or greater)

Trash services can **only** be provided by one of the registered commercial haulers

Recycling services can **only** be provided by one of the registered commercial haulers **OR** one of the county-authorized recyclers



COMMERCIAL

Trash services can **only** be provided by one of the registered commercial haulers

Recycling services can **only** be provided by one of the registered commercial haulers **OR** one of the county-authorized recyclers

EXCEPTIONS:

Self-Haul

“Residential” Cart Service can be provided by Republic Services if space is an issue for a trash or recycling dumpster



CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION

Trash services can **only** be provided by one of the registered commercial haulers

Recycling services can **only** be provided by one of the registered commercial haulers **OR** one of the county-authorized recyclers

EXCEPTIONS:

Self-Haul

Hired Contractor and/or Sub-Contractor(s) can haul the trash and recyclables generated during their work
