Subject: **City Manager's General Administrative Report for April 22, 2009**

This is a report by the City Manager to the Elk Grove City Council. This report provides information on issues affecting the City and the progress of City activities.

Prop 1B State and Local Partnership Program

The California Transportation Commission adopted the first year list of projects for the Prop 1B State and Local Partnership Program. This is a statewide \$10 million/year competitive program reserved for projects that have a developer fee match. The City has two projects totaling \$1.9 million on this approved list: the Waterman/Grantline Intersection Project and the Franklin/Elk Grove Intersection Project.

New Medical Office Building

On April 16, the Planning Commission approved a design review for a new 62,000 square foot medical office building for Kaiser Permanente. It will be located along Promenade Parkway and Highway 99 in the previously approved Promenade Square immediately north of the future mall. Development Services management staff will organize a team to help expedite this project through the construction process.

Reward from the Governor's Office

A \$50,000 reward has been offered by the Governor's Office for information leading to the arrest and conviction of those responsible for the January 2006 murder of 15-year-old Robert Maisonet. Anyone with information on the case is asked to call the Elk Grove Police Department at (916) 478-8000.
