Storm Water General Construction Permit

The State Water Board has a new General Construction Permit that will take effect July 1, 2010. All public and private construction projects will be responsible for complying with the new permit criteria. Oak Tree Removal

Public Works has been monitoring the health of the large oak tree at the intersection of Bond Road and Elk Grove-Florin Road. The health of the tree has been rapidly declining. Due to the proximity of the tree to traffic and concerns regarding a catastrophic failure, the tree will have to be removed. The island will remain and be replanted. To minimize impacts to traffic, the tree will be scheduled for removal during the evening within the next two weeks.
