**Historic Preservation**

The City of Elk Grove has a rich heritage depicted in numerous California State Landmarks and properties listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Historic preservation helps establish a community's identity rooted in a shared past. The most effective tool to aid historic preservation efforts is a local historic preservation ordinance. **Appointment and Term.** Appointments are made by a vote of the City Council; the term of appointment is for two years.
