Economic Development Programs



1. Employment Training Panel Program

This Program allows for up to 50% reimbursement of wages during a training period. The training period is designated by the company, but cannot exceed six months. In some cases, where necessary, out-of-state training may be an eligible reimbursable cost. The training program is designed by the business to meet their performance needs. An average training reimbursement amount under the Employment Training Panel Program is \$2,500-3,000. This program is available to businesses statewide.

2. Sacramento Training and Response Team (S.T.A.R.T.)

The S.T.A.R.T. group is comprised of representatives from federal, state, and local job training agencies, working together to assist businesses. In the Sacramento Area, the S.T.A.R.T. group can assist companies with recruiting, screening, and implementing any required testing of new employees. If a company locates within an Enterprise Zone, the S.T.A.R.T. group will recruit employees that will allow the company to maximize benefits under the program. This program is available to businesses in the Greater Sacramento Area.

3. Economic Revitalization Manufacturing Property Tax Rebate

As of January 1, 1994, local jurisdictions have the authority to rebate the property tax paid by employers for tangible personal property that is directly involved in the manufacturing process. City or county governments, through a majority vote of the local governing body, determine the amount of the rebate and whether the property meets the following qualifications:

- The property must be directly involved in the activity of converting or conditioning a product by changing the form, composition, quality, or character of the product for ultimate sale at retail or use in the manufacturing of a product to be ultimately sold at retail.
- Use of the property must lead to the creation of at least 10 new full-time manufacturing jobs or positions at salary levels of at least \$10.00 per hour. The newly created jobs must remain in existence for five years.

This program is available in all jurisdictions, but must be approved by the elected body of that jurisdiction.

4. Statewide Community Infrastructure Program (SCIP)

The purpose of the SCIP program is to help fund the development of certain impact fees. The local agency can negotiate with the developer to have the fees paid upon approval of a specific plan, development agreement or vesting tentative map and then fund the fees through SCIP. Fees paid to a local agency to mitigate the impact of development and which will ultimately be used by the local agency to pay for the costs of public infrastructure. Improvements identified in the 1913/1915 Assessment Act and supported by the City's program includes Streets and Roadways, and Freeway Interchanges.

5. Electric Utility Providers

In Sacramento County and all the cities therein, the current electrical provider is the Sacramento Municipal Utility District (SMUD). SMUD has a reduced (blended) rate for industrial companies locating anywhere in SMUD territory.
