

# Neighborhood Cleanup Program



Helping residents keep their property and neighborhoods free from trash, junk and rubbish, the City of Elk Grove provides a Neighborhood Cleanup service once each year for bulky items.

The Annual Curbside Cleanup Day gives residents the ability to put large materials out for collection in front of their residence and on the same side of the street no sooner than two days prior to the pickup date.

The map provided shows the month of pickup for each neighborhood. One week before the scheduled pickup date, residents will receive a reminder door hanger with the date, details and what items can go out and when.

## Rules for Neighborhood Cleanup Program

Material cannot be placed curbside more than 2 days prior to the assigned collection day. Material that is placed out before the two-day allowable timeframe will be collected, and the homeowner will automatically be billed a fee.

### Acceptable materials include:

old toys, appliances, furniture, PVC pipes<sup>1</sup>, lumber and junk<sup>2</sup>, prunings, tree branches, fencing<sup>3</sup>

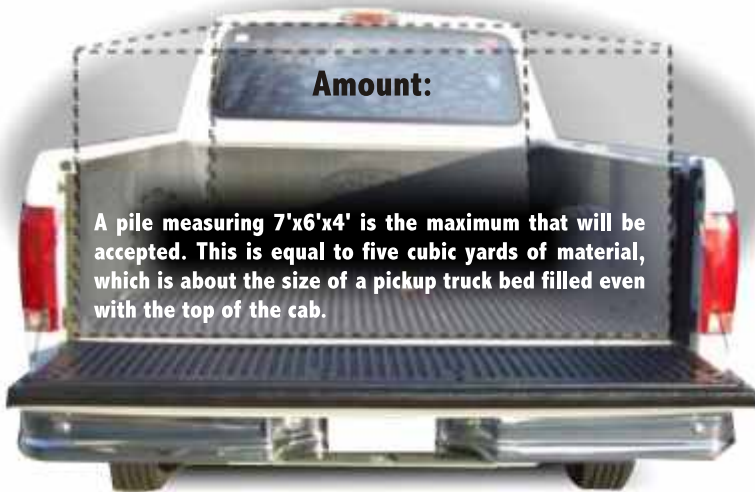
<sup>3</sup>Fences must be disassembled

<sup>2</sup>Lumber cannot exceed 6 feet

<sup>1</sup>Pipe cannot exceed 3 feet

### Unacceptable materials include:

tires, TVs, computer monitors\*, commercial waste, dirt, rocks, bricks, tree stumps, combustible materials, liquids, toxic materials, household garbage, steel pipes, batteries and heavy materials, such as auto bodies bumpers and engines, paints, pesticides or solvents.



## Note on e-waste

Due to recent changes in landfill regulations, tires, televisions, and computer monitors are no longer accepted in the Annual Curbside Cleanup Day. But remember, you can take these items to the e-waste recycling events for free. See the list on page 2 of this newsletter

## Oversized Piles

If a resident places more than the allowed 5 cubic yards of material curbside, Allied Waste crews will collect the first 5



cubic yards and leave a Non-Collection Notice (tag) on the remaining material. Allied will then notify the resident in order to schedule an additional pickup and a charge will be billed to the resident for the remaining materials. Anything over 5 cubic yards will not be picked up unless the resident has called in advance to notify Allied Waste at (916) 635-2500.

### Regarding the Cost Charged for Oversized Piles

Charges for excess materials are as follows:

#### Calls in Advance

\$16.83 will be charged for each additional 5 cubic yards beyond the first free 5 cubic yards that are collected, assuming the resident called in advance and the collection of all the material is done on the same day as the normal Neighborhood Cleanup.

#### Computer Monitors and Televisions

\$39.26 will be charged to have any number of these items collected at one location. Discards containing cathode ray tubes (such as TVs and computer monitors) will be picked up for a surcharge during Neighborhood Cleanup only if you have called in advance.
