Elk Grove Police Investigate Shooting

ELK GROVE, CA – On Wednesday, June 6, 2007 at 12:17 p.m., the Elk Grove Police Department responded to the 9200 block of Gem Crest way regarding a shooting that had taken place.

The Elk Grove Police Department and medical personnel arrived at the above location and discovered two victims on the front porch. The first victim, Mia Zepata (19), was suffering from several gunshots to the upper torso. The second victim, Adrien Abeyta (18), was suffering from blunt force trauma to his head area. Both victims of the assault were transported to a local area hospital for medical treatment and are expected to recover. Based on information developed at the scene, the suspects were described as a Caucasian male adult and an African-American male adult both in their twenties.

Detectives were able to determine that a verbal argument between the victims and the suspects took place on the front porch of the residence on Gem Crest Way. During the confrontation, the suspects physical attacked Abeyta causing injuries to the head area and fired several shots at Zepata striking her several times. Both suspects then fled the scene westbound on Gem Crest Way in a late 1995 early 2000 GMC Yukon or Chevrolet Tahoe style 2 door, black or dark blue in color.
