### **Elk Grove Police Investigate Shooting**

**ELK GROVE, CA** – On Friday, June 8, 2007 at 11:51 p.m., the Elk Grove Police Department responded to the 9500 block of Tarbert Drive regarding a disturbance call at a graduation party. As officers responded to the location, dispatch advised that several callers had now reported hearing gunshots coming from the same location.

The Elk Grove Police Department arrived at the above location and discovered a 15-year old male victim suffering from several gunshot wounds to his upper torso. The victim of the assault was transported to a local area hospital for medical treatment and he is in stable condition at this time.

Based on information developed at the scene, Detectives were able to determine that a verbal argument between several groups took place in the 9500 block of Tarbert Way. The verbal argument escalated into a physical altercation in which several individuals became involved. During the physical altercation, an unidentified suspect produced a pistol and shot the victim several times. The suspect responsible for the shooting then fled the area. Detectives are continuing to contact witnesses and are in the process of developing suspect information.
