Elk Grove Click it or Ticket Results

ELK GROVE, CA – The Elk Grove Police Department participated in the “Click it or Ticket” seat belt enforcement campaign from May 14 through June 3 of this year. During this operation, the Elk Grove Police Department issued 882 citations to individuals who were not wearing their seat belts. In additions, 29 drivers were cited for not having children in age-appropriate child safety seats.

During the “Click it or Ticket” campaign, officers also issued drivers 487 other citations for vehicle code violations. 32 vehicles were towed during the campaign and 102 drivers were issued citations for operating a motor vehicle without a license or with a suspended license. Officers also issued 218 citations to uninsured motorist and made 8 felony arrests, 3 warrant arrests and 5 drug arrest. The Elk Grove Police Department conducted the intensive enforcement as part of the statewide “Click it or Ticket” campaign. Overtime for the enforcement campaign was provided by a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.
