Fatal Traffic Collision - Single Vehicle

ELK GROVE, CA – On June 30, 2007 at 9:08 p.m., the Elk Grove Police Department responded to a 911 call regarding a traffic collision in the 9900 block of Bruceville Road.

Upon arrival, officers discovered that a vehicle traveling northbound in the 9900 block of Bruceville Road had collided with a tree. As a result of the collision, a rear passenger who was not wearing a seatbelt was killed upon impact. The other four passengers, all suffered serious injuries (non-life threatening) and were transported to local area hospitals for treatment. The name of the deceased passenger is not being released at this time. Identification of the passenger will be made by the Sacramento County Coroner's Office. The female occupants of the vehicle are all believed to be between 15 and 18 years of age.

According to witnesses, the vehicle was observed traveling in an erratic manner prior to the collision. At this point, speed appears to have played a role in the collision. The Elk Grove Police Department Traffic Bureau will be conducting an investigation into the collision.
