Elk Grove Police Conduct Warrant Sweep

ELK GROVE, CA – On Wednesday, September 12, 2007, the Elk Grove Police Department along with the Federal Bureau of Investigations (FBI), the Sacramento Police Department, the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department, Sacramento County Probation, the Department of Corrections and the U.S. Marshall's Office conducted a one day probation/parole compliance check within the City of Elk Grove.

The operation, known as J.A.W.S (Joint Agency Warrant Sweep) utilized over 65 sworn law enforcement officers. The operation targeted individuals known to be on parole or probation, or those known to have active arrest warrants. During the one day operation, officers made 16 arrests and contacted 186 individuals. "This operation was a huge success for our department," said Police Chief Robert Simmons. "The intelligence that was gathered from this operation will be extremely useful in future operations."
