### **Bank Forgery Suspect Sought**

**ELK GROVE, CA** – The Elk Grove Police Department is asking for the community’s help in identifying a subject involved in a passing several fictitious checks in the Elk Grove area.

On August 30, 2007, the subject pictured below entered a Washington Mutual branch and impersonated a customer by using the victim’s identification. The subject then deposited a fictitious check in the amount of \$1,250.00 and then removed the funds she had just deposited. Over the next three days, the subject deposited an additional seven fictitious checks into Washington Mutual locations in Elk Grove and the City of Orange, California. The deposits totaled over \$7,000.00 and this amount was removed from the victim’s account.

The subject is described as a Caucasian female, approximately twenty to thirty year of age, five feet six inches tall (5’6”), one hundred and fifty pounds (150 lbs.), with blonde shoulder length hair. The subject appears to be pregnant in the bank surveillance photos.
