### **Elk Grove Police Investigate Shooting**

**ELK GROVE, CA** – On Monday, December 17, 2007 at 11:19 p.m., an Elk Grove Police Officer on routine patrol was hailed by two individuals in a pickup truck at Colton Avenue and Elk Grove Boulevard. The officer made contact with the occupants (Charles Rommel, 47 and Lorisa Crisjohn, 43) and discovered that both occupants were suffering from gunshot wounds. Rommel was suffering from a gun shot wound to the lower torso, while Crisjohn was suffering from a gun shot wound to the upper torso.

Medical personnel arrived at the officer's location and began providing treatment to the injured individuals. Both Rommel and Crisjohn were transported to a local area hospital and are in stable condition. Based on information provided by the victims, officers responded to a residence in the 9400 block of Ranch Park Drive. Upon arrival at the residence, officers determined that a shooting had taken place inside the residence. There were no additional victims located inside the residence, and the suspects responsible had fled the scene.

At this point, Detectives are working on establishing a motive for the shooting and are attempting to obtain information regarding the person(s) responsible.
